A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Tyler Swayne on attaining the rank of Eagle Scout; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Tyler Swayne of Troop 388 located in Watkinsville, Georgia, has attained the
3 rank of Eagle Scout, the most distinguished rank conferred by the Boy Scouts of America,
4 and received the Eagle Scout Award at an Eagle Scout Court of Honor on March 27, 2004;

6 WHEREAS, since 1911, the Eagle Scout Award has been the symbol of the highest and most
7 prestigious achievement among the Boy Scouts of America; and

8 WHEREAS, a candidate for the most exceptional award in scouting must complete a
9 rigorous program of training and demonstrate his proficiency in selected scouting techniques
10 and attainment of the highest ideals of scouting; and

11 WHEREAS, the attainment of this rank indicates that a scout has developed leadership
12 ability, self-confidence, mature judgment, and mental and physical capabilities that will be
13 of immense benefit throughout his life; and

14 WHEREAS, only two of every 100 boys who join Cub Scouts achieve the rank of Eagle
15 Scout; and

16 WHEREAS, this outstanding young man has truly exhibited a commitment to the scouting
17 principles of honesty and fairness and has consistently conducted himself in a manner
18 becoming an Eagle Scout; and

19 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper for this body to recognize the outstanding
20 accomplishments of this extraordinary young man.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
2 the members of this body commend and congratulate Tyler Swayne on achieving the rank
3 of Eagle Scout.
