

1 SENATE AMENDMENT TO HB 1011:

2 Amend HB 1011 (LC 22 5329) by striking lines 1 and 2 of page 1 and inserting in its place
3 the following: "To amend part 7 of Article 7 of Chapter 3 of Title 20 of the Official Code of
4 Georgia Annotated, relating to HOPE scholarships, so as to provide that employees of certain
5 organizations are considered residents of Georgia for purposes of the HOPE program; to add
6 public and private schools". By inserting between lines 6 and 7 of page 1 the following:

7 **"SECTION 1.**

8 Part 7 of Article 7 of Chapter 3 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
9 relating to HOPE scholarships, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
10 '20-3-519.13.

11 Any residency requirements established pursuant to this part shall provide, at a minimum,
12 that full-time Georgia employees of Free Trade Area of the Americas (FTAA) based in
13 Georgia that are recognized by the United States Department of State, and their spouses
14 and dependents, shall be classified as residents of Georgia."

15 By renumbering Sections 1 and 2 as Sections 2 and 3 respectively.
