1 Senators Crotts of the 17th, Mullis of the 53rd and Brush of the 24th offered the following  
2 amendment:

3 Amend the Senate Public Safety and Homeland Security Committee substitute to HB 217 by  
4 inserting following "vehicles;" on line 6 of page 1 the following:  
5 "to provide that certain persons may operate or ride upon a motorcycle without wearing  
6 protective headgear under certain circumstances;"

7 By redesignating Sections 3 and 4 as Sections 4 and 5, respectively.

8 By inserting following line 13 of page 5 the following:

9 **"SECTION 3.**

10 Said part is further amended by adding a new Code Section 40-8-76.2 to read as follows:  
11 '40-8-76.2.

12 Notwithstanding Code Section 40-6-315 or any other provision of this title, a person 21  
13 years of age or older may operate or ride upon a motorcycle without wearing protective  
14 headgear securely fastened upon his or her head if such person is covered by an insurance  
15 policy providing for at least \$10,000.00 in medical benefits for injuries incurred as a result  
16 of a crash while operating or riding upon a motorcycle."
