## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the Atlanta Job Corps Center; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the Atlanta Job Corps Center is one of 19 Job Corps centers in the country  
3 established under the auspices of the National Job Corps Program; and
- 4 WHEREAS, the National Job Corps Program is a no-cost education and training program  
5 administered by the U.S. Department of Labor that helps disadvantaged young people ages  
6 16 through 24 to get better jobs, to make more money, and to take control of their lives; and
- 7 WHEREAS, funded by the U. S. Congress, Job Corps has been training young adults for  
8 meaningful careers since 1964; and
- 9 WHEREAS, students of the Atlanta Job Corps Center are offered the opportunity to learn a  
10 trade, to earn a GED or a high school diploma, and to get help in finding employment; and
- 11 WHEREAS, additionally, the Atlanta Job Corps Center gives students the opportunity to  
12 learn in a diverse setting, to encounter new experiences, to learn about workplace  
13 expectations, and to learn how to succeed in their chosen career fields; and
- 14 WHEREAS, the Atlanta Job Corps Center focuses on developing employability and personal  
15 responsibility skills; and
- 16 WHEREAS, the thousands of graduates of Atlanta Job Corps programs are employed at all  
17 levels of the work force throughout the country and are productive and contributing citizens;  
18 an impressive number have joined the armed forces; and many have attended colleges and  
19 universities throughout the country.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
2 commend the Atlanta Job Corps Center for the great service it is performing for our state and  
3 country, but especially for its service to our young citizens.

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed  
5 to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the Atlanta Job Corps Center.
