A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing Georgia Conservation Voters; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Georgia Conservation Voters is a state-wide, nonpartisan organization working
3 to protect and preserve Georgia's natural heritage and the economic opportunities that
4 heritage provides for future generations; and
- 5 WHEREAS, the organization has dedicated its efforts and energy to supporting and electing
6 lawmakers and public officials who recognize the vital importance of and respect Georgia's
7 vast ecosystem; and
- 8 WHEREAS, a quality environment is the bedrock and the foundation upon which the success
9 of this state's pursuits and future are built; and
- 10 WHEREAS, it is the mission of Georgia Conservation Voters to keep state lawmakers
11 focused on the need to protect Georgia's pristine and beautiful surroundings while
12 maintaining a high quality of life for all Georgians; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Georgia Conservation Voters is committed to working as partners, not
14 adversaries, with legislators, government officials, and public interests to find the best
15 strategies and methods for preserving and enhancing Georgia's precious natural resources.
- 16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
17 recognize Georgia Conservation Voters for its tireless efforts to protect and preserve
18 Georgia's environment and its commitment to ensuring a high quality of life for all the
