

**LOST**

1 Senators Meyer von Bremen of the 12th and Harp of the 16th offered the following  
2 amendment:

3 Amend the Senate Health and Human Services Committee substitute to HB 1303 (LC 33  
4 0453S) by striking the quotation marks at the end of line 25 of page 4 and by inserting  
5 between lines 25 and 26 of page 4 the following:

6 "(d) In the event the patient or a representative of the patient requests in writing the  
7 monetary amount of the lien created by Code Section 44-14-470 and the hospital, nursing  
8 home, physician practice, or provider of traumatic burn care medical practice fails to  
9 supply said information within 20 days of receipt of the written request, the patient shall  
10 not be bound or otherwise affected by the lien as long as the following conditions have  
11 been satisfied:

12 (1) The request is conveyed to the hospital, nursing home, physician practice, or  
13 provider of traumatic burn care medical practice by certified or registered mail or  
14 authorized overnight carrier;

15 (2) If submitted by a representative of the patient, an authorization in compliance with  
16 any state or federal laws, properly executed by the patient, is attached to the request; and

17 (3) The full name and date of birth of the patient is included in the request.

18 Upon proof that the information requested was provided by the hospital, nursing home,  
19 physician practice, or provider of traumatic burn care medical practice to the patient by  
20 certified or registered mail or authorized overnight carrier, the lien shall be effective."
