A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Mr. Bill Malone, the only Athenian to croak at the Alamo,
- 2 and the Bill Malone Society; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, Mr. Bill Malone was renowned throughout Athens, Georgia, as a man of low
- 4 character and ill repute, even for his day; and
- 5 WHEREAS, no longer able to avoid his father's disdain for dissipation, Mr. Malone left his

- 10 incident so shameful and ugly that he fled the scene and didn't stop until he reached New
- 11 Orleans; and
- 12 WHEREAS, though his fondest associates were prone to consider him a scalawag, varlet, and
- drunken hoodlum, Mr. Malone has the timeless honor and distinction of being the only
- 14 contribution the City of Athens made in the valiant and heroic fight against General Santa
- 15 Anna's vicious, bloodthirsty army at the Alamo; and
- 16 WHEREAS, the Bill Malone Society, formed in honor of this famed and noble knight of
- 17 Athens, is now celebrating its tenth anniversary through its yearly assemblage of Texans and
- 18 Athenians; and
