- 1 In memory and honoring the life of Mr. T.J. Hall; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the City of Flovilla lost one of its most outstanding leaders and citizens with the
3 passing of long-time Flovilla city councilman T.J. Hall on Sunday, January 18, 2004; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Mr. Hall was born on August 4, 1928, in Copper Hill, Tennessee, to his loving
5 parents, Clifford and Anna Mae Partain Hall; and
- 6 WHEREAS, he faithfully and courageously served his country as a member of the United
7 States Army during the Korean Conflict; and
- 8 WHEREAS, he married the love of his life, the late Mrs. Frances Irene Guy Hall; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Mr. Hall moved to Flovilla in 1976 and in 1988 was elected to the Flovilla City
10 Council and was forced to resign shortly after due to poor health; and
- 11 WHEREAS, in 1998 he once again was elected to the Flovilla City Council and continued
12 to serve on the council until his passing; and
- 13 WHEREAS, he was a Mason, a member of Ben Hill Lodge Number 674, and was a Shriner;

- 15 WHEREAS, he is survived by his beautiful daughters, LaQueeta Hunt and Pam Perdue; six
16 grandchildren; and one great-grandchild.
