A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Mr. Steve Reynolds; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Mr. Steve Reynolds served in the Georgia State Senate from 1968 to 1982,
3 providing steadfast leadership as chairman of the Transportation Committee for 12 years and
4 he was an integral and valuable participant of the Rules Committee, Human Resources
5 Committee, Offender Rehabilitation Committee, Senate Administrative Affairs Committee,
6 Industry Committee, Labor Committee, and Appropriations Committee; and

7 WHEREAS, the Mr. Reynolds served with distinction and unparalleled ability as a member
8 of the State Transportation Board from 1984 through April, 2004; and

9 WHEREAS, as a distinguished veteran of the United States Army and World War II, he
10 served his nation honorably; and

12 talents, and energy toward the betterment of his community and state as evidenced by his 20
13 years of service as a member of the State Transportation Board and his 14 years of service
14 as a member of the Georgia State Senate; and

16 thorough consideration of transportation issues have enriched the Georgia Department of
17 Transportation; and

18 WHEREAS, he is a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation for
19 integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness; and

20 WHEREAS, Mr. Reynolds has devoted his life to the high calling of public service and has
21 earned the respect of the State Transportation Board and of all Georgians for his exemplary
22 stewardship of the public trust.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
2 the members of this body honor and commend Mr. Steve Reynolds for the high quality of
3 service he has provided his community, the State Transportation Board, the state Senate, and
4 the State of Georgia and express to him their best wishes for the future.
