A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend an Act to provide for the election of the members of the board of education of
- 2 Columbia County, approved March 21, 1968 (Ga. L. 1968, p. 2708), as amended, so as to
- 3 provide for the holding of a nonbinding referendum in the Columbia County School District
- 4 in conjunction with the 2004 General Election on the question of whether the chairperson of
- 5 the Columbia County Board of Education should be elected by the voters of the entire
- 6 Columbia County School District; to provide for related matters; to require submission of
- 7 this Act for preclearance pursuant to Section 5 of the federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as
- 8 amended; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

- 11 An Act to provide for the election of the members of the board of education of Columbia
- 12 County, approved March 21, 1968 (Ga. L. 1968, p. 2708), as amended, is amended by adding
- 13 a new Section 6A to read as follows:

- 14 "SECTION 6A.
- Unless otherwise prohibited by the federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended, the
- 16 election superintendent of Columbia County shall call and conduct an election on the date
- of the 2004 General Election as provided in this section for the purpose of submitting to
- the electors of the Columbia County School District a nonbinding referendum on the
- 19 question of whether the chairperson of the Columbia County Board of Education should
- 20 be elected by the voters of the entire Columbia County School District. The election
- superintendent shall issue the call and conduct such election as provided by general law.
- The superintendent shall cause the date and purpose of the election to be published once
- a week for two weeks immediately preceding the date thereof in the official organ of
- Columbia County. The ballot shall have written or printed thereon the words:

1 'NONBINDING REFERENDUM

- 2 () YES Shall the chairperson of the Columbia County Board of Education be
- 3 () NO elected by the voters of the entire Columbia County School District?'
- 4 All persons desiring to vote in favor of electing the chairperson of the Columbia County
- 5 Board of Education by the voters of the entire Columbia County School District shall vote
- 6 'Yes,' and all persons desiring to vote against electing the chairperson of the Columbia
- 7 County Board of Education by the voters of the entire Columbia County School District
- 8 shall vote 'No.' The expense of such election shall be borne by the Columbia County Board
- 9 of Education."

SECTION 2.

- 11 The Board of Education of Columbia County shall through its legal counsel cause this Act
- 12 to be submitted for preclearance under the federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended;
- and such submission shall be made to the United States Department of Justice or filed with
- 14 the appropriate court no later than 45 days after the date on which this Act is approved by the
- 15 Governor or otherwise becomes law without such approval.

SECTION 3.

17 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
