A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 20-2-690 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 requirements for private schools and home study programs, so as to change certain
- 3 qualifications of tutors in home study programs; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 4 purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Code Section 20-2-690 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to requirements
- 8 for private schools and home study programs, is amended by striking paragraph (3) of
- 9 subsection (c) and inserting in its place a new paragraph (3) to read as follows:
- 10 "(3) Parents or guardians may teach only their own children in the home study program,
- provided the teaching parent or guardian possesses at least a high school diploma or a
- general educational development (GED) diploma, but the parents or guardians may
- employ a tutor who holds at least a baccalaureate college degree a high school diploma
- or a general educational development diploma to teach such children;".

16 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
