4 Headmaster Ferrell Singleton, has won the Region 8A championship title and the Georgia
5 High School Association Class A Literary Meet state championship title; and

7 as a whole, based upon the individual placement of each team or competitor; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Lakeview Academy's Nick Johnson took first place in boys' extemporaneous

18 persons gave Lakeview Academy everything it needed to best their rivals from Seminole
19 County to claim the Georgia High School Association Class A Literary Meet state
20 championship title.
