1 Honoring and remembering the life and service of Mr. James Randolph Smith; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the City of Swainsboro and the State of Georgia lost one of its finest city
4 councilpersons and United States armed forces veterans with the passing of Mr. James
5 Randolph Smith on March 3, 2004; and

6 WHEREAS, Mr. James Randolph Smith was born in Emanuel County, Georgia, to his
7 parents, Roy Clyde Smith and Claudia Forehand Smith; and

8 WHEREAS, he dutifully and courageously served his country during World War II as a
9 member of the United States Army Air Corps and was again called upon by his country to
10 serve during the Korean Conflict; and

11 WHEREAS, the former president of the Citizens Bank of Swainsboro, he was also a 26 year
12 member of the Swainsboro city council and had served as Swainsboro's Mayor Pro Tempore;

14 WHEREAS, he was a faithful and treasured member of the First United Methodist Church,
15 the Swainsboro Golf and Country Club, and the Saturday Night Supper Club; and

16 WHEREAS, he is survived by his loving wife, Ann Garrison Smith; daughters Claudia Haun
17 and Nancy Lisenby; and five glorious grandchildren and a great-granddaughter.

19 the members of this body honor and remember the life and civil and military service of Mr.
