- 3 WHEREAS, Carolyn Wills was born and raised in Memphis, Tennessee, and spent summer
- 4 vacations in North Georgia with her godparents; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Carolyn Wills accepted a job with the Fannin County Development Authority
- 6 in September of 2001; and
- 7 WHEREAS, not long after she took the job, the Levi Strauss plant in Blue Ridge closed,
- 8 leaving hundreds of people without jobs; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Carolyn Wills formed a community task force to help address the needs of
- 10 displaced workers when Levi Strauss closed its plant; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Carolyn Wills negotiated with Levi Strauss for the county's purchase of the Levi
- 12 Strauss property and helped relocate a new manufacturer, Kismet, on the property; and
- 13 Kismet currently employs 120 people; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Kismet's old building became available for an expansion of Whitepath-Fabtec,
- which will eventually employ 75 people; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Carolyn Wills helped develop a funding package for Hampton Square, a
- 17 mixed-use development including Georgia Mountain Fiber and the Blue Ridge Community
- 18 Theater; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Carolyn Wills established a business development center at Epworth which
- 20 provided a new home for an Appalachian Technical College satellite campus; and
