- 1 Recognizing August 6-12, 2004, as "Purple Heart Week" in honor of this state's and our
- 2 nation's combat wounded veterans; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, on August 7, 1782, at his Newburgh, New York, headquarters, General George
- 4 Washington devised the Badge of Military Merit in the figure of a heart in purple cloth; and
- 5 WHEREAS, the United States War Department later designated the Badge of Military Merit
- 6 as the Purple Heart on February 22, 1932; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the Military Order of the Purple Heart of the United States of America,
- 8 Incorporated, was chartered by Congress on August 26, 1958, as the only organization of
- 9 combat wounded veterans; and
- 10 WHEREAS, the Military Order of the Purple Heart is celebrating the 222nd anniversary of
- 11 the establishment of the Purple Heart by General George Washington.
- 12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- the members of this body recognize August 6-12, 2004, as "Purple Heart Week" in honor of
- 14 combat wounded veterans.
- 15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the Military Order of the
- 17 Purple Heart of the United States of America, Incorporated.
