A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Donna Jean Brogan; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Donna Jean Brogan has long been recognized for the vital role that she has
3 played in leadership and her deep personal commitment to the welfare of the citizens of
4 Georgia and the United States; and

5 WHEREAS, she has diligently and conscientiously dedicated innumerable hours of her time,
6 talents, and energy toward the betterment of her community and state as evidenced
7 dramatically by her many years of superlative service to Emory University where she became
8 the first woman to be appointed to a faculty position in the Department of Biometry and
9 Statistics at the Emory School of Medicine, the fourth woman to be promoted to professor
10 of the Emory School of Medicine, and the first woman to be named chair of the Biostatistics
11 Department in the School of Public Health; and

12 WHEREAS, she has devoted much of her research to women's health issues, especially to
13 breast cancer and reproductive health; and

14 WHEREAS, her significant organizational and leadership talents, her remarkable patience
15 and diplomacy, her keen sense of vision, and her sensitivity to the needs of the citizens of her
16 community have earned her the respect and admiration of her colleagues and associates; and

17 WHEREAS, she is a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation for
18 integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness; and

19 WHEREAS, she was named a winner of the 2004 Unsung Heroine Award by the Emory
20 Women's Center of Emory University, and it is abundantly fitting and proper that the
21 outstanding accomplishments of this remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately
22 recognized.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
2 commend Donna Jean Brogan for her many years of efficient, effective, unselfish, and
3 dedicated public service and extend to her their most sincere best wishes for continued health
4 and happiness.
