## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending and saluting Alto Park Elementary School and congratulating it on being  
2 named an Effective Practices School; and for other purposes.

4 Georgia, has been recognized by the Georgia School Council Institute as an Effective  
5 Practices School; and

8 similar schools from around the state; and

13 school councils so that they may be a more integral part of Georgia's efforts to improve

16 quality of education in Rome and the State of Georgia; and

18 in this state, it is wholly fitting and proper that Alto Park Elementary School be appropriately  
19 recognized.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
21 the members of this body commend and salute Alto Park Elementary School for its

1 significant and positive contributions to public education in Georgia and congratulate it on
