A RESOLUTION

1 Commending the Alpharetta Fire and Emergency Services; and for other purposes.

9 Rogers, FF/PMDC Lori Wood, FF/FAE Wes McCall, FF/PMDC Tristen Cruz, FF/EMT

12 with the help and protection of such dedicated and vital individuals; and
