three and a half years in the Pacific Theatre during World War II; and

11 WHEREAS, he helped develop the Mark Trail character into the nation's greatest

12 preservationist of its natural resources of woods, water, and wildlife for future generations

13 reaching nearly 23 million readers worldwide; and

14 WHEREAS, since succeeding Ed Dodd as the chief writer and artist for Mark Trail in 1978,

15 he has produced a variety of materials for the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service to help teach

16 schoolchildren respect for the environment; and

17 WHEREAS, he has assisted the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA)

by making Mark Trail the voice of the National Weather Service and NOAA Weather Radio;and

- 1 WHEREAS, he was honored in 1988 by President Ronald Reagan for his efforts to develop
- 2 more pride in America and to reduce carelessness and abusive activity such as littering,
- 3 vandalism and theft, and wildlife poaching; and
- WHEREAS, he has been married to his wonderful wife, the former Mary Anne Candee, for
 54 years and they have four children and 11 grandchildren all totally devoted to the
 conservationist principles taught by Mark Trail.

9 80th birthday and their hopes that he will continue to lead Mark Trail and his friends well
