2 WHEREAS, Scott Hanson is a successful businessman and a leading citizen whose
3 contributions to his community have been significant; and

4 WHEREAS, a resident of Smyrna, Georgia, he is the co-owner of the Direct Marketing
5 Group; and

6 WHEREAS, he has been actively involved in politics since serving as a staff assistant in the
7 United States Senate in 1972; and

8 WHEREAS, he has served as chairman of the Republican Party in Fulton County and in the
9 Fifth District and as first vice chairman of the state party and was a member of the Advance
10 Team for Vice President George Bush from 1980 to 1986; and

11 WHEREAS, from 1990 to 1994, he served as a member of the Mayor's Green Ribbon
12 Committee for Parks for the City of Atlanta; and

14 through his long service as Director of the Buckhead Baseball Little League; and
