16 back-to-back state champion; and

17 WHEREAS, he is survived by his son, Christopher Cubino; father and stepmother, Robert
18 and Carol Cubino; mother and stepfather, Terri and James Brand; and sisters, Toni, Katie,
19 Brenda, Gail, Vanessa, and Becky.
