A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend an Act entitled "An Act to provide a new charter for the City of Ball Ground,"
- 2 approved March 28, 1990 (Ga. L. 1990, p. 4552), as amended, particularly by an Act
- 3 approved March 27, 1998 (Ga. L. 1998, p. 3949), so as to change the corporate limits of the
- 4 city by annexing certain property; to limit the jurisdiction of the municipal court with respect
- 5 to such property; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 An Act entitled "An Act to provide a new charter for the City of Ball Ground," approved
- 9 March 28, 1990 (Ga. L. 1990, p. 4552), as amended, particularly by an Act approved March
- 10 27, 1998 (Ga. L. 1998, p. 3949), is amended by inserting at the end of Section 1.11 a new
- 11 subsection to read as follows:
- 12 "(d) In addition to any property within the corporate boundaries of the city on the date this
- subsection becomes effective in 2004, the corporate boundaries of the city shall also
- include the following described property, to wit: all that right of way of Interstate Highway
- 15 I-575 between Sharp Mountain Creek and the boundary between Cherokee and Pickens
- 16 Counties, for a distance of 4.4 miles. However, as authorized under subsection (a) of Code
- 17 Section 36-32-1, this property shall be excepted from the jurisdiction of the municipal
- court of the City of Ball Ground; the municipal court shall have no jurisdiction over the
- property described in this subsection; and jurisdiction over such property shall be in the
- state and superior courts of Cherokee County or as otherwise provided by general law."
