

House Bill 1833 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act creating the Lamar County Livestock and Agricultural Exposition
2 Authority, approved March 25, 1996 (Ga. L. 1996, p. 3703), as amended, so as to change
3 the provisions relating to the membership of the authority; to repeal conflicting laws; and for
4 other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 An Act creating the Lamar County Livestock and Agricultural Exposition Authority,
8 approved March 25, 1996 (Ga. L. 1996, p. 3703), as amended, is amended by striking
9 subsection (b) of Section 3 and inserting in its place the following:

10 "(b) The authority shall consist of nine members. Four of such members shall be residents
11 of Lamar County appointed by the governing authority thereof; two of such members shall
12 be residents of Lamar County appointed by the governing authority of the City of
13 Barnesville; one of such members shall be a resident of Lamar County appointed by
14 governing authority of the City of Milner; one of such members shall be a resident of
15 Lamar County appointed by the governing authority of the Town of Aldora; and one of
16 such members shall be a resident of Lamar County appointed by the governing authority
17 of the City of Barnesville and County of Lamar Development Authority. The governing
18 authority of Lamar County shall appoint one of its members on the authority for an initial
19 term of one year, one of its members on the authority for an initial term of two years, one
20 of its members on the authority for an initial term of four years, and one of its members on
21 the authority for an initial term of five years. The governing authority of the City of
22 Barnesville shall appoint one of its members on the authority for an initial term of one year
23 and the other of its members on the authority for an initial term of two years. The
24 remaining three members on the authority shall be appointed for initial terms of three years.
25 After the expiration of these initial terms, members shall be appointed for terms of office
26 of three years each. Members of the authority shall serve the terms specified and until their

respective successors are appointed and qualified. Any member of the authority may be selected and appointed to succeed himself or herself. After such appointment, the members of such authority shall enter upon their duties. Any vacancy on the authority shall be filled in the same manner as was the original appointment of the member whose term of membership resulted in such vacancy and the person so selected and appointed shall serve for the remainder of the unexpired term. The members of the authority shall be reimbursed for all actual expenses incurred in the performance of their duties out of funds of the authority. The authority shall make rules and regulations for its own government. It shall have perpetual existence."

SECTION 2.

All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
