- 2 WHEREAS, Honorable Peg Blich has served with unparalleled ability as a member of the
3 Georgia State Senate since 1993; and
- 4 WHEREAS, this dynamic and powerful public servant has faithfully represented the citizens
5 of her diverse senatorial district with great distinction, dedication, and ability; and
