

Senate Resolution 25EX

A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Chief H. Randy Camp and the chief officers and members of the Walker
2 County Emergency Services; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Walker County Emergency Services recently received an ISO Class 4 rating
4 for its fire protection services; and

5 WHEREAS, the ISO rates the quality of fire protection services for a community and has
6 established a classification system for rating fire protection services that ranges from the
7 lowest rating of Class 10 to the highest rating of Class 1; and

8 WHEREAS, the ISO rating is used by insurance companies in pricing insurance for
9 communities with lower insurance premiums being charged for those communities with
10 higher ISO classifications; and

11 WHEREAS, only 6.9 percent of all fire departments nationwide have an ISO Class 4 rating
12 and only 76 fire departments in the State of Georgia have a Class 4 rating, of which only two
13 are county-run and consisting primarily of volunteers; and

14 WHEREAS, it is through the diligent and dedicated efforts of Chief H. Randy Camp and the
15 chief officers and members of the Walker County Emergency Services that the ISO Class 4
16 rating was obtained; and

17 WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper that Chief Camp and the chief officers and members of
18 the Walker County Emergency Services be recognized for their extraordinary and
19 outstanding efforts on behalf of the citizens of Walker County.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
21 recognize and commend Chief H. Randy Camp and the chief officers and members of the

1 Walker County Emergency Services for their dedicated service and hard work in achieving
2 an ISO Class 4 rating.

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
4 to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to Chief H. Randy Camp.
