A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing Honorable Roger Hines upon the occasion of his retirement from membership
2 in the General Assembly; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Honorable Roger Hines of Kennesaw was elected to the House of
4 Representatives in 2000 and reelected in 2002; and

5 WHEREAS, his distinguished service as a member of this House was preceded by many
6 years of service to the public as an educator in public and private schools and colleges and
7 as chairman of the Georgia Professional Practices Commission and by service to his
8 profession as director of the Professional Association of Georgia Educators, among many
9 other endeavors; and

10 WHEREAS, Rep. Hines is not seeking reelection to the General Assembly in 2004 but has
11 instead qualified as a candidate for election to the United States Congress; and

12 WHEREAS, he is married to Nancy Milligan Hines and has four children, Christy, Wendy,
13 Jeff, and Reagan, and four grandchildren; and

14 WHEREAS, it is only fitting and proper that he be recognized by this body.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
16 the members of this body recognize Honorable Roger Hines upon the occasion of his
17 retirement as a member of the General Assembly, commend him for his long and
18 distinguished public service, and express their best wishes for his future.
