A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Honorable Warren Massey and congratulating him on his appointment to the
2 State Board of Workers' Compensation; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Honorable Warren Massey has been a dedicated public servant, ably
4 representing the constituents of the 24th district in the House of Representatives since being
5 elected in 1996 and subsequently re-elected in 1998, 2000, and 2002; and

16 WHEREAS, Mr. Massey's abilities and integrity have been recognized in his appointment
17 by Governor Sonny Perdue, announced April 22, 2004, to the State Board of Workers'
18 Compensation, where he will serve as one of three appellate judges on the board; and

19 WHEREAS, although his expertise and experience will be sorely missed by this body, he
20 will be a strong asset to the state in his new role on the State Board of Workers'
21 Compensation and it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments
22 of this remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

2 the members of this body commend Honorable Warren Massey for his exemplary public
3 service to his constituents and to the State of Georgia and convey to him their deep
