A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending Joshua Wesley Dahl on becoming an Eagle Scout; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Joshua Wesley Dahl has earned the rank of Eagle Scout, which will be awarded
3 during a ceremony on January 25, 2005; and
- 4 WHEREAS, since 1911, the Eagle Scout Award has been the symbol of the highest and most
5 prestigious achievement among the Boy Scouts of America; and
- 6 WHEREAS, the attainment of Eagle Scout rank indicates that a Scout has developed
7 leadership ability, self-confidence, mature judgment, and mental and physical capabilities
8 that will be of immense benefit throughout life; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Joshua Wesley Dahl has amply demonstrated to his Scout leaders and peers that
10 he possesses these qualities along with sterling character; and
- 11 WHEREAS, for a Scout to reach Eagle rank, he must earn 21 merit badges, 12 of which are
12 mandatory requirements for the Eagle Scout program; and
- 13 WHEREAS, in achieving Eagle Scout status, Joshua Wesley Dahl has brought honor not
14 only to himself but also to his family and troop.
- 15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
16 recognize and commend Joshua Wesley Dahl for his diligence and dedication in pursuing the
17 highest honor awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and congratulate him on attaining the
18 prestigious rank of Eagle Scout.
