A RESOLUTION

1 Remembering and honoring the life of Archie Thomas "A.T." Mauldin; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Mr. Mauldin served his country with great honor as a member of the United
4 States Army Air Corps during World War II and served in the European Campaign for four
5 years, earning the Bronze Star with oak leaf cluster as well as six battle stars and citations
6 from the French and Belgian governments; and

7 WHEREAS, in 1932, Mr. Mauldin settled in Franklin County where he was a much loved
8 teacher of vocational agriculture at Line, Lavonia, and Franklin County High School until
9 his retirement in 1964; and

10 WHEREAS, Mr. Mauldin zealously represented the 12th District in the General Assembly
11 and served on the Appropriations and Education Committees as well as the State Vocational
12 Educational Council and the Georgia Education Improvement Council, using the expertise
13 he gained from his successful teaching career to improve the quality of education for
14 Georgia's children; and

15 WHEREAS, Mr. Mauldin was a dedicated and active member of his community involved
16 in numerous civic organizations and a devoted family man with four grandchildren and five
17 great-grandchildren; and

18 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia has lost one of its most distinguished statesmen with the
19 passing of Mr. Archie Thomas Mauldin.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
21 the members of this body join together to express their deepest regret at the passing of Mr.
22 Archie Thomas "A.T." Mauldin and extend their most sincere condolences to his family.
