A RESOLUTION

- 1 Requesting that the United States Congress work to pass legislation allowing hybrid or
- 2 alternative fueled passenger vehicles to use high occupancy vehicle (HOV) lanes; and for
- 3 other purposes.
- 4 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia is striving to reduce air pollution in the state, particularly
- 5 in the heavily congested metropolitan areas; and
- 6 WHEREAS, hybrid or alternative fueled vehicles produce much less air pollution than
- 7 traditional fueled vehicles; and
- 8 WHEREAS, it will provide an incentive to citizens to purchase hybrid or alternative fueled
- 9 vehicles if they are allowed to drive them in the HOV lanes in metropolitan areas; and
- 10 WHEREAS, the use of HOV lanes by these hybrid vehicles will increase their visibility and
- 11 desirability while improving air quality in the state.
- 12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 GEORGIA that this body requests the United States Congress pass legislation allowing
- 14 hybrid or alternative fueled passenger vehicles to use established HOV lanes.
- 15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- and directed to transmit appropriate copies of this resolution to the President of the United
- 17 States Senate, the Speaker of the United States House of Representatives, and each member
- 18 of the Georgia Congressional delegation.
