

House Resolution 64

A RESOLUTION

1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution so as to provide that the House of
2 Representatives shall consist of not more than 180 Representatives apportioned among
3 single-member representative districts of the state; to provide for the submission of this
4 amendment for ratification or rejection; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 Article III, Section II, Paragraph I of the Constitution is amended by striking subparagraph
8 (b) thereof and inserting in its place the following:

9 "(b) The House of Representatives shall consist of not ~~fewer~~ more than 180
10 Representatives apportioned among single-member representative districts of the state."

11 **SECTION 2.**

12 The above proposed amendment to the Constitution shall be published and submitted as
13 provided in Article X, Section I, Paragraph II of the Constitution. The ballot submitting the
14 above proposed amendment shall have written or printed thereon the following:

15 "() YES Shall the Constitution of Georgia be amended so as to provide that the House
16 of Representatives shall consist of not more than 180 Representatives
17 () NO apportioned among single-member representative districts of the state?"

18 All persons desiring to vote in favor of ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "Yes."
19 All persons desiring to vote against ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "No." If
20 such amendment shall be ratified as provided in said Paragraph of the Constitution, it shall
21 become a part of the Constitution of the state.
