A RESOLUTION

- 1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution so as to provide that the House of
- 2 Representatives shall consist of not more than 180 Representatives apportioned among
- 3 single-member representative districts of the state; to provide for the submission of this
- 4 amendment for ratification or rejection; and for other purposes.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Article III, Section II, Paragraph I of the Constitution is amended by striking subparagraph
- 8 (b) thereof and inserting in its place the following:
- 9 "(b) The House of Representatives shall consist of not fewer more than 180
- Representatives apportioned among <u>single-member</u> representative districts of the state."

SECTION 2.

- 12 The above proposed amendment to the Constitution shall be published and submitted as
- provided in Article X, Section I, Paragraph II of the Constitution. The ballot submitting the
- 14 above proposed amendment shall have written or printed thereon the following:
- 15 "() YES Shall the Constitution of Georgia be amended so as to provide that the House
- of Representatives shall consist of not more than 180 Representatives
- 17 () NO apportioned among single-member representative districts of the state?"
- 18 All persons desiring to vote in favor of ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "Yes."
- 19 All persons desiring to vote against ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "No." If
- such amendment shall be ratified as provided in said Paragraph of the Constitution, it shall
- 21 become a part of the Constitution of the state.
