A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Article 1 of Chapter 2 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
2 relating to registration and licensing of motor vehicles generally, so as to prohibit the use of
3 plastic or other types of material covering license plates; to provide for related matters; to
4 provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 style="text-align:center">**SECTION 1.**

7 Article 1 of Chapter 2 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
8 registration and licensing of motor vehicles, is amended by inserting immediately following
9 Code Section 40-2-6 a new Code Section 40-2-6.1 to read as follows:

10 "40-2-6.1.

11 Any person who willfully covers any license plate with plastic or other material in order
12 to prevent or impede the ability of surveillance equipment to clearly photograph or
13 otherwise obtain a clear image of the license plate is guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be
14 punished by a fine of \$1,000.00."

15 style="text-align:center">**SECTION 2.**

16 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2005.

18 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
