GEORGIA that the bridge at Peterson Avenue and Madison Avenue over 20 Mile Creek in
Coffee County, Georgia, is designated the DeWayne King, USMC, Memorial Bridge.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs designating said bridge.
