A RESOLUTION

1 Remembering and honoring the life of Lucius Black; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Mr. Lucius Black was born on July 27, 1915, in Webster County, Georgia, a
3 community to which he was dedicated throughout his distinguished career as a public
4 servant; and

5 WHEREAS, during his service in the House of Representatives of the State of Georgia from
6 1945 to 1948 and from 1951 to 1972, Mr. Black was regarded as a man of outstanding
7 character with an exceptional understanding of state and county government, which was
8 highly valued and respected by his fellow members in the General Assembly; and

9 WHEREAS, Mr. Black continued his public service as sole commissioner of Webster County
10 from 1977 to 1990 and then as chairman of the reconstituted county commission from 1991
11 to 1996; and

12 WHEREAS, in the course of his career, he demonstrated great energy, intelligence, ability,
13 and dedication to the betterment of the State of Georgia and the quality of life of its citizens;
14 and

15 WHEREAS, with the passing of Mr. Lucius Black on October 18, 2004, the State of Georgia
16 has lost a most estimable citizen and statesman.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
18 the members of this body join together to express their deepest regret at the passing of Mr.
19 Lucius Black and extend their most sincere condolences to his family and the community of
20 Webster County.
