## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Coosa High School, winners of the 2004 AA Governor's Cup  
2 and inviting its students, teachers, and administrators to appear before the House of  
3 Representatives; and for other purposes.

4 WHEREAS, the students of Coosa High School have made a 115 point improvement on their  
5 SAT scores from 2003 and have attained a 99 percent passing rate on the Georgia High  
6 School Graduation Writing Test to earn the 2004 AA Governor's Cup; and

7 WHEREAS, Coosa High School, a 2003 Georgia School of Excellence, has numerous  
8 academic, fine arts, and athletic achievements to its name and has received the highest ratings  
9 by parents from Greatschools.net; and

10 WHEREAS, Coosa High School students made it to the second round in the 2005 WSB-TV  
11 High Q Competition and were Overall Second Runners Up in the 2004 PAGE Academic  
12 Decathlon Super Quiz, and the Academic Decathlon Team was named Floyd County  
13 Champions for the second year in a row, a title it has held for 14 of the last 17 years; and

14 WHEREAS, 12 band members were chosen for the University of West Georgia's Honor  
15 Band and student Jeremy Deaton was named 2004-2005 FBLA State Reporter while the  
16 2004 Football Team came in eighth in the state for Class AA and the 2004 Basketball Team  
17 was among the Class AA Elite Eight for the third consecutive year; and

18 WHEREAS, these admirable achievements are the result of the outstanding efforts of the  
19 dedicated and hard working administration, faculty, and staff, and the bright, focused, and  
20 determined students of Coosa High School; and

21 WHEREAS, these students have brought great credit and honor to their school, community,  
22 and the State of Georgia through their many achievements and have set a laudable example  
23 for all those students who will attend Coosa High School in the years to come; and

1 WHEREAS, the Floyd County community and the State of Georgia take great pride in the  
2 accomplishments of this superlative school.

3 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
4 the members of this body join in recognizing and commending the students, teachers, and  
5 administrators of Coosa High School, winners of the 2004 AA Governor's Cup.
