## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending Peter Owen Scheidt on becoming an Eagle Scout; and for other purposes.

- 5 WHEREAS, since 1911, the Eagle has been the symbol of the highest achievement among  
6 the Boy Scouts of America; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the attainment of Eagle Scout rank indicates that a Scout has developed  
8 leadership ability, self-confidence, mature judgment, and mental and physical capabilities  
9 that will be of immense benefit throughout life; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Peter Owen Scheidt has amply demonstrated to his Scout leaders and peers that  
11 he possesses these qualities along with sterling character; and
- 12 WHEREAS, for a Scout to reach Eagle rank, he must earn 21 merit badges, 12 of which are  
13 mandatory requirements for the Eagle Scout program; and
- 14 WHEREAS, in achieving Eagle Scout status, Peter Owen Scheidt has brought honor not only  
15 to himself but also to his family and troop.
