A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Collin Rose; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Collin Rose of Boy Scout Troop 3143 has attained the rank of Eagle Scout, the
3 most distinguished rank conferred by the Boy Scouts of America, which will be awarded to
4 him at an Eagle Court of Honor on February 5, 2005; and

5 WHEREAS, a candidate for this most exceptional award in scouting must complete a
6 rigorous program of training and demonstrate his proficiency in selected scouting techniques
7 and attainment of the highest ideals of scouting; and

8 WHEREAS, only one scout out of 97 ever reaches this lofty level of achievement and Collin
9 Rose has ably demonstrated his aptitude and competency in mastering the various special
10 skills taught through the Boy Scout program; and

11 WHEREAS, this outstanding young man has truly exhibited a commitment to the scouting
12 principles of honesty and fairness and has consistently conducted himself in a manner
13 becoming of an Eagle Scout; and

14 WHEREAS, in a world which consistently seems to accentuate the negative aspects of the
15 actions of young people, it is abundantly fitting and proper for this body to recognize with
16 particularity the outstanding accomplishments of this extraordinary individual.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
18 commend Collin Rose for his diligence and dedication in pursuing the highest honor awarded
19 by the Boy Scouts of America and congratulate him on attaining the prestigious rank of
20 Eagle Scout.
