## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Creating the Henry McNeal Turner Tribute Commission and authorizing the placement of
- 2 a statue on the grounds of the state capitol building; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, Henry McNeal Turner was born near Abbeville, South Carolina, in 1834 and
- 4 was ordained to preach in 1853; and
- 5 WHEREAS, during the Civil War, he became the first African American to hold the position
- 6 of chaplain in the U.S. Army, and after the war he was active in Georgia state politics and
- 7 he served in the General Assembly; and
- 8 WHEREAS, when African Americans were expelled from the General Assembly in 1868,
- 9 he delivered a rousing oratory in protest of their treatment; and
- 10 WHEREAS, he became the 12th A.M.E. Bishop in 1880, and for 12 years he served as
- 11 chancellor of Morris Brown College, now Morris Brown University, and he donated land in
- 12 Atlanta for the construction of a school for African American children; and
- 13 WHEREAS, it is only right that this great man in Georgia history be recognized.
- 14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 GEORGIA:
- SECTION 1.
- 17 (a) There is created the Henry McNeal Turner Tribute Commission to be composed of 11
- 18 members selected as follows:
- 19 (1) Two members appointed by the Governor, with a chairperson and vice chairperson
- to be designated by the Governor from among these members;
- 21 (2) Two members appointed by the President of the Senate;

1 (3) One member appointed by the Georgia Senate Committee on Assignments and one

- 2 member each to be appointed by the Georgia Senate Majority and Minority Leaders; and
- 3 (4) Two members appointed by the Speaker of the Georgia House of Representatives and
- 4 one member each to the appointed by the Majority and Minority Leaders of the Georgia
- 5 House of Representatives.
- 6 (b) Membership on the commission shall not constitute the holding of a public office and
- 7 the members of the commission shall serve without compensation.
- 8 (c) The commission shall exist for an indefinite term as may be necessary to complete its
- 9 work and shall be dissolved by resolution of the commission upon completion of its work.

## SECTION 2.

- 11 The commission is authorized to:
- 12 (1) Provide for the commissioning of a statue of Henry McNeal Turner, the same to be
- accomplished solely through voluntary contributions to the commission or such fund or
- funds as it may establish or designate for such purpose;
- 15 (2) Provide for the selection and design of an appropriate placement for such statue on
- or adjacent to the grounds of the Georgia state capitol building, provided that the site
- selected and the design of the placement shall be approved by the State Properties
- 18 Commission;
- 19 (3) Solicit and accept gifts, donations, and grants in furtherance of its purposes; and
- 20 (4) Work cooperatively with any private group, organization, association, or corporation
- 21 having the same general purpose as the commission.

## SECTION 3.

- 23 Upon completion of the commission's work, the Governor shall be authorized to accept and
- 24 provide for the dedication of a statue of Henry McNeal Turner to be placed on or adjacent
- 25 to the grounds of the state capitol building.
