A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend an Act creating the State Court of Cobb County, approved March 26, 1964 (Ga.
- 2 L. 1964, p. 3211), as amended, particularly by an Act approved May 30, 2003 (Ga. L. 2003,
- p. 3693), so as to change the compensation of the solicitor-general; to change the provisions
- 4 relating to the compensation of assistant solicitors; to provide for related matters; to provide
- 5 an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 An Act creating the State Court of Cobb County, approved March 26, 1964 (Ga. L. 1964, p.
- 9 3211), as amended, particularly by an Act approved May 30, 2003 (Ga. L. 2003, p. 3693),
- 10 is amended by striking paragraph (1) of subsection (b) of Section 27 of said Act and inserting
- in its place a new paragraph to read as follows:
- 12 "(1) On the effective date of this Act, the solicitor-general of Cobb County shall receive
- an annual salary of \$125,265.00 to be paid in biweekly installments from the funds of
- 14 Cobb County."

15 SECTION 2.

- 16 Said Act is further amended by striking subsection (d) of Section 27 and inserting in its place
- 17 a new subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 18 "(d) The solicitor-general shall have the authority to appoint the same number of assistant
- solicitors as the number of judges of Division I and Division II of the State Court of Cobb
- 20 County and the same number of additional assistant solicitors as the number of magistrates
- of the Magistrate Court of Cobb County, plus three additional assistant solicitors, one of
- 22 whom shall be the chief assistant solicitor, one of whom may be the deputy assistant
- solicitor, and one of whom may serve as an intake attorney at the Cobb County Adult
- 24 Detention Center. The compensation of such assistant solicitors shall be determined by the
- solicitor-general. The compensation of the chief assistant solicitor shall not exceed

1 \$91,227.00, payable in biweekly installments from the funds of Cobb County. The

- 2 compensation of the deputy assistant solicitor shall not exceed \$85,164.00, payable in
- 3 biweekly installments from the funds of Cobb County. The compensation of other assistant
- 4 solicitors shall not exceed \$74,869.00 and shall be paid in the same manner as all other
- 5 assistant solicitors. The solicitor-general shall prescribe the duties and assignments of said
- 6 assistant solicitors and, while so employed, they shall not engage in the private practice of
- 7 law."

8 SECTION 3.

- 9 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 10 without such approval.

11 SECTION 4.

12 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
