A RESOLUTION

1 Relative to adjournment; and for other purposes.

2 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that, unless otherwise
3 provided by subsequent resolution of the General Assembly, the meeting dates and dates of
4 adjournment for the 2005 regular session of the General Assembly for the period of
5 February 10, 2005, through March 2, 2005, shall be as follows:

- 13 Thursday, February 17 in session for legislative day 20
- 14 Friday, February 18 in session for legislative day 21
- 15 Saturday, February 19 in adjournment
- 16 Sunday, February 20 in adjournment
- 17 Monday, February 21 in adjournment
- 18 Tuesday, February 22 in session for legislative day 22
- 19 Wednesday, February 23 in session for legislative day 23
- 20 Thursday, February 24 in session for legislative day 24
- 21 Friday, February 25 in session for legislative day 25
- 22 Saturday, February 26 in adjournment
- 23 Sunday, February 27 in adjournment

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that on and after March 2, 2005, the periods of adjournment
28 of the 2005 session, if any, shall be as specified by subsequent resolution of the General
29 Assembly, except that for the remainder of the 2005 regular session, unless otherwise

1 provided by subsequent resolution, the General Assembly shall adjourn at the close of the
2 legislative day on each Friday on which the General Assembly is in session and shall
3 reconvene on the following Monday.

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, as authorized by Code Section 28-1-2, the hours for
5 closing and convening the Senate on each day may be as ordered by the Senate; and the
6 hours for closing and convening the House on each day may be as ordered by the House.
