1	To amend Article 1 of Chapter 2 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated
2	relating to registration and licensing of motor vehicles generally, so as to prohibit the use of
3	plastic, other types of material, or body parts covering license plates; to provide for related
4	matters; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:
6	SECTION 1.
7	Article 1 of Chapter 2 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
8	registration and licensing of motor vehicles, is amended by inserting immediately following
9	Code Section 40-2-6 a new Code Section 40-2-6.1 to read as follows:
10	"40-2-6.1.
11	Any person who willfully covers any license plate with plastic, other material, or any par-
12	of his or her body in order to prevent or impede the ability of surveillance equipment to
13	clearly photograph or otherwise obtain a clear image of the license plate is guilty of a
14	misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine not to exceed \$1,000.00."
15	SECTION 2.
16	This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2005.
17	SECTION 3.

All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
