A RESOLUTION

5 ten children’s hospitals in America; and

7 four specialty programs: the AFLAC Cancer Center and Blood Disorders Service ranked
8 third; the neonatal intensive care unit ranked third; the orthopaedics program ranked third;
9 and the Sibley Heart Center ranked fourth, for the second consecutive year; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Children’s Healthcare of Atlanta, a nonprofit hospital, is well known for its
11 compassionate care and stellar staff; and
- 12 WHEREAS, these latest rankings confirm the experience of many young patients and their
13 families, who will not be surprised that a national survey has documented the excellence of
14 Children’s Healthcare of Atlanta; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Children’s Healthcare of Atlanta is an asset to the metropolitan Atlanta area and
16 to the state.
