A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring Colonel William "Bill" Hitchens, Jr.; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, on January 9, 2003, Governor-elect Sonny Perdue appointed Colonel William
- 3 "Bill" Hitchens to become the first Director of the Georgia Office of Homeland Security; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Colonel Hitchens's career spans more than 35 years of government service in
- 5 the military and state law enforcement; and
- 6 WHEREAS, he served four years in the Marine Corps, which included a 13 month stint in
- 7 Vietnam and served 28 years on the Georgia State Patrol; and
- 8 WHEREAS, throughout most of his career with the Georgia State Patrol, Colonel Hitchens
- 9 maintained a parallel career with the Coast Guard Reserve from which he retired in 2000
- 10 with the rank of Commander (0-5); and
- 11 WHEREAS, in May, 2000, via an Executive Order by the Governor, Colonel Hitchens was
- 12 named Executive Commander of the G-8 Public Safety Command; and
- 13 WHEREAS, he was placed in charge of all state efforts to coordinate law enforcement and
- public safety operations for the Group of Eight (G-8) Summit held June 8-10, 2004, on Sea
- 15 Island, Georgia; and
- 16 WHEREAS, coordinated by Colonel Hitchens, the state effort included approximately
- 17 10,000 public safety and Georgia National Guard personnel from around the state and was
- 18 by all accounts an unprecedented success; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Georgia's G-8 Summit has been established as the model and standard for such
- 20 events in years to come as a direct result of the remarkable leadership of Colonel Hitchens;
