A RESOLUTION

1 Designating the intersection of State Highway 515 and State Highway 53 as "Disabled
2 American Veterans Intersection"; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, all Americans enjoy the benefits of living in a free country; and

4 WHEREAS, this freedom does not come without a price; and

5 WHEREAS, many men and women in the history of our nation have risen to the call and
6 performed their duty to defend this country and our freedoms in times of conflict; and

7 WHEREAS, many of these gallant men and women have paid a high personal price in the
8 defense of liberty with the loss of their sight, hearing, and mobility and with other
9 disabilities; and

10 WHEREAS, proper recognition of the service and sacrifice of these brave men and women
11 is most appropriate.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 GEORGIA that the members of this body honor disabled American veterans, both living and
14 deceased, and designate the intersection of State Highway 515 and State Highway 53 in
15 Pickens County as "Disabled American Veterans Intersection."

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
17 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs so designating the intersection.

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
19 and directed to transmit appropriate copies of this resolution to the Pickens Chapter #47 of
20 the Disabled American Veterans and the Department of Transportation.
