A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 36-71-4 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 calculation of and requirements relative to development impact fees imposed by local
- 3 governments, so as to provide a maximum amount of impact fees which may be imposed
- 4 with respect to the construction of a new single family residence; to provide for related
- 5 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Code Section 36-71-4 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to calculation of
- 9 and requirements relative to development impact fees imposed by local governments, is
- amended by adding at its end a new subsection (s) to read as follows:
- 11 "(s) The total of all impact fees imposed with respect to the construction of a new single
- family residence constructed for sale shall not exceed 2 percent of the price at which the
- 13 residence is first sold by the party constructing the residence. Where a single family
- residence is constructed by the owner for occupancy by the owner, the total of all impact
- 15 fees imposed with respect to the construction of the residence shall not exceed 2 percent
- of the cost of the residence to the owner, including the costs of the land and construction
- paid by the owner. A municipal or county development impact fee ordinance shall provide
- 18 for the refund of excess impact fees where the total of impact fees initially paid on or after
- July 1, 2005, exceeds the 2 percent cap imposed by this subsection."

SECTION 2.

21 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
