- 8 of rules, regulations, and standards by the Department of Human Resources and county
- 9 boards of health, is amended by striking subsection (a) and inserting in lieu thereof the
- 10 following:

- 11 "(a) For the purpose of protecting the public health, the Department of Human Resources
- 12 shall have the power to adopt and promulgate such rules and regulations as it deems
- 13 necessary and proper to carry out the purpose and intent of this article, including the
- 14 establishment of reasonable standards of sanitation for food service establishments and
- 15 such establishments which are also retail frozen dessert packagers and the examination and
- 16 condemnation of unwholesome food therein. The Department of Human Resources shall
- 17 establish a uniform grading sheet with respect to inspecting food service establishments for
- the purpose of meeting the standards established by the department, and such grading sheet 18
- shall be utilized statewide no later than January 1, 2006. The Department of Human 19
- 20 Resources shall promulgate rules and regulations for posting the uniform grading sheet in
- each food service establishment. County boards of health are authorized to adopt and 22 promulgate supplementary rules and regulations, including the establishment of reasonable
- 23 standards of sanitation for food service establishments, consistent with those adopted and
- promulgated by the department and may provide a supplemental grading sheet which may 24
- supplement the state-wide grading sheet but shall not replace the state-wide grading sheet. 25
