A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing The Links, Incorporated, and inviting the officers thereof to appear before the
2 House; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, The Links, Incorporated, is an organization comprised of women of African
4 heritage who are committed to enriching, sustaining, and ensuring the identities, culture, and
5 economic survival of all people of African origin through cultural, educational, and civic
6 programs; and

7 WHEREAS, The Links, Incorporated, was founded in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, in 1946
8 on the fundamentals of friendship and service; and

9 WHEREAS, The Links, Incorporated, conducts programs through strategic public
10 information and education, economic development, and public policy to provide enrichment
11 experiences in the areas of the arts, services to youth, national trends and services, and
12 international trends and services; and

13 WHEREAS, on February 25, 2005, the members of the Southern Area of The Links,
14 Incorporated, will attend "Links Day at the Capitol" to promote the passage of Healthy
15 People 2010 legislation designed to eliminate health disparities and to focus on reducing
16 infant mortality, cancer, cardiovascular disease, diabetes, and HIV/AIDS and encouraging
17 immunizations; and

18 WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper to recognize the efforts of this group.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
20 the members of this body recognize and commend The Links, Incorporated, for its work to
21 improve the quality of life in this state and nation and wish the members of The Links,
22 Incorporated, continued success.

2 are invited to appear before the House of Representatives for purposes of being recognized
