## A RESOLUTION

1 Remembering and honoring the life of Mr. Edward H. "Ned" Gignilliat; and for other  
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, on August 28, 1944, Mr. Edward H. "Ned" Gignilliat was born in Augusta,  
4 Georgia, to loving parents William R. Gignilliat, Jr., and Ann Harris Gignilliat; and

5 WHEREAS, after graduating from Gainesville High School in 1962, Mr. Gignilliat attended  
6 the University of the South, Sewanee, where he was a member of the Phi Delta Theta  
7 fraternity; and

8 WHEREAS, he served his country with honor in his local United States National Guard from  
9 1966 until 1973; and

11 Cleaners, providing excellent service to his customers in the downtown Gainesville; and

12 WHEREAS, this benevolent man was a dedicated and active member of Grace Episcopal  
13 Church, the Gainesville Kiwanis Club, and Habitat for Humanity of Hall County as well as  
14 a Scout leader of Boy Scout Troop 16; and

15 WHEREAS, Mr. Gignilliat will also be remembered as an avid outdoorsman who enjoyed  
16 sharing his love of skiing, hiking, golfing, fly fishing, and horseback riding with his family  
17 and his many friends; and

18 WHEREAS, he leaves behind his devoted family, including his parents; his beloved sons,  
19 Harris McKenzie Gignilliat and William Stuart Gignilliat; his brothers, William R. Gignilliat  
20 III and Charles O. Gignilliat; his sisters-in-law, Laura Lieberman and Brenda Gignilliat; his  
21 nephews, Rob, Heyward, and Darrell Gignilliat; and his nieces, Elizabeth Ann Gignilliat and  
22 Meigan Gignilliat Herold, her husband, Seth Herold, and their children, Kady and Taylor,
