

House Bill 582

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 47-2-99 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
2 applicability of creditable service in the Employees' Retirement System of Georgia for
3 persons employed in a temporary full-time position, so as to provide that credit may be
4 granted for service covered by Chapter 22 of Title 47, the Georgia Defined Contribution
5 Plan; to provide conditions for an effective date and automatic repeal, to repeal conflicting
6 laws; and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 **SECTION 1.**

9 Code Section 47-2-99 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the applicability
10 of creditable service in the Employees' Retirement System of Georgia for persons employed
11 in a temporary full-time position, is amended by striking in its entirety subsection (a) and
12 inserting in lieu thereof the following:

13 "(a) Any member of the retirement system, including a member subject to the provisions
14 of Code Section 47-2-334, who was, at any time prior to becoming a member, employed
15 by an employer as a temporary full-time employee, may obtain up to 12 months of
16 creditable service for such service as a temporary full-time employee under the conditions
17 contained in this Code section; ~~provided, however, that no such credit shall be granted for~~
18 ~~any period which was covered under Chapter 22 of this title, relating to the Georgia~~
19 ~~Defined Contribution Plan."~~

20 **SECTION 2.**

21 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2006, only if it is determined to have been
22 concurrently funded as provided in Chapter 20 of Title 47 of the Official Code of Georgia
23 Annotated, the "Public Retirement Systems Standards Law"; otherwise, this Act shall not
24 become effective and shall be automatically repealed in its entirety on July 1, 2006, as
25 required by subsection (a) of Code Section 47-20-50.

SECTION 3.

2 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
